

How to Prepare Using Novels

Read the chapter three times. The first time, read for the story and summarize. The second time, identify characters and unfamiliar vocabulary. The third reading should focus on storytelling: visualization of the story and ASL signs for concepts and spatial descriptions. Finally, use the teacher's lesson plans, CliffsNotes, and/or SparkNotes for more information, analysis, and symbolism in the novel.
